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### SUMMARY

Full-Stack Engineer with experience across the delivery cycle — from database modeling and API design to frontend work with React and Next.js, including building component libraries with Storybook during an internship at [Vidio.com](#) . Recently worked on integrating DeepSeek AI into a fintech reconciliation system, turning a manual process into something more automated. Backend stack covers TypeScript, Express/NestJS, Bun/NodeJS, and PostgreSQL, with additional background in Android development (Kotlin + Jetpack Compose) that helps when jumping between contexts. Still growing, but the kind of person who takes that seriously — learning deliberately and applying it to real things.

As the team's technical lead on a three-person project, I was responsible for establishing the entire project foundation before a single feature line was written — defining the layered backend architecture (router → controller → service → repository), the feature-based frontend module structure, Git branching conventions, and deployment pipeline to Vercel and Neon.tech. The task was to build a location-aware online grocery platform where every product, order, and admin interaction is scoped to the nearest store branch from the user's location. My feature scope covered the homepage with browser geolocation and Haversine-based store selection, a full authentication system with email verification and JWT refresh token rotation, multi-address management with interactive Leaflet maps and OpenCage reverse geocoding, RajaOngkir shipping cost integration cached to the database for reliability, and store management with role-based admin assignment. The challenge wasn't just the technical complexity — it was building all of this while also writing unit tests using a TDD approach across 7 service-layer test files, ensuring business logic stayed isolated and mockable. The result was a fully deployed, production-grade application with clean architecture that the whole team could build on consistently.

### ClaraAI, AI-Assisted Reconciliation Automation Tool

Before ClaraAI existed, reconciliation was an entirely manual process — the developer team would receive raw transaction data from clients, clean and separate it by hand, manually input it into MSSQL, and then run the reconciliation executable. The whole cycle took one to two weeks per run. I was tasked with building an AI-assisted tool that could guide users step by step through that same process: ingesting CSV data, cleaning and mapping fields, generating matching key suggestions via DeepSeek AI, producing the XML configuration used by the internal reconciliation engine, and triggering the reconciliation job — all through a structured UI. The hardest part wasn't the integration itself but making the AI output consistent and reliable enough to be usable in a financial context; prompt engineering for reconciliation logic required significant iteration to get outputs that aligned with real business rules. The result brought that two-week process down to roughly one day for standard reconciliation cases, with accuracy sitting at 65–75% depending on data complexity — honest numbers that made it a practical tool for simpler reconciliation workloads while the team continues to refine it.

This is a solo-ish end-to-end project I am building for a family-owned property consultancy business, collaborating with a dedicated UI/UX designer and a legal team to ensure the product is both polished and compliant. The core design constraint came early: the primary users are older adults who don't use laptops or desktops, so despite building a web application, I committed to a strict mobile-first approach where every interaction and information hierarchy is designed around a small-screen, less technically fluent user. One of the more significant features I implemented is a document generation system for lease and sale agreements — built in close consultation with the legal team to ensure every clause is legally sound — where agents can fill out a structured form, preview the document in real time similar to a CV builder, and export or print it directly from the browser as a production-ready PDF. On the infrastructure side, I set up CI on both backend and frontend, applied TDD on the backend, and am deploying via Docker to a Biznet Gio VPS with CD planned as the next milestone. Building it end-to-end across backend, frontend, legal compliance, and infrastructure has sharpened my ability to make pragmatic decisions while staying aligned with both a designer's vision and real-world business requirements.

Working as one half of a two-person team, I owned Feature 2 entirely — user authentication and authorization, a referral system with points and coupon expiration logic, profile management, and the organizer dashboard with statistics visualization. The situation was more than just a technical one: my teammate was going through his first experience working in a structured team workflow, so part of my responsibility was guiding him through branching conventions, code review, and keeping us both on timeline — while we also had no UI/UX designer, meaning every design decision had to be reasoned through together from scratch. I balanced mentoring alongside my own delivery, which slowed things at points but meant we finished with a shared understanding of the codebase. The outcome was a working mini project covering the full feature scope, and personally a stronger sense of how to keep a team moving without a dedicated design resource.

Bangkit Academy Capstone · Kotlin, Jetpack Compose, Retrofit, MVVM, Dependency Injection, FastAPI (ML backend)

Our six-person cross-functional team — two Android, two Cloud, two ML — set out to build a mobile app that could detect skin diseases from a photo, with the ML model served through a dedicated FastAPI backend rather than bundled on-device. On the Android side, I made a deliberate architectural decision early on: despite the team's primary familiarity with XML-based layouts, I pushed to use Jetpack Compose for the UI layer, knowing it was the direction Android development was heading and that the Bangkit curriculum had introduced it. The challenge was absorbing Compose's declarative paradigm in parallel with building the actual product, integrating Retrofit for the ML inference API calls, and keeping the MVVM structure clean with proper dependency injection. The project came together well enough to earn a 90 out of 100 in the capstone evaluation, and graduating from Bangkit with that score validated that the technical risk of choosing Compose was the right call.
